On 28 September 2025, the Apter family tragically lost their beloved daughter and sister, Sheridan, at just 35 years old. In the midst of their grief, one thing was clear, Sheridan's life had to be honoured in a way that truly reflected who she was and what she loved. For Sheridan, that was netball.

Over 27 years, she played, umpired, coached and mentored. "We had to honour Sheridan in a meaningful way and create a proper legacy." said John Apter, Sheridan's father. The family looked for an organisation that embodied her core values of inclusion, confidence and opportunity. That search led them to the Confident Girls Foundation, a charity established in 2015 built on empowering girls through the power of netball. The organisation supports women and girls aged 5 to 30 experiencing disadvantage, creating opportunities to build confidence, resilience, and leadership skills.

The inaugural event will be held at St George Leagues Club on March 21 in support of The Confident Girls Foundation. Featuring a trivia night and auction to raise funds for this great cause and to celebrate and honour Sheridan's life.
