# The Mission

At Confident Girls Foundation, we believe every girl deserves the opportunity to thrive. Through the power of netball, we provide girls and young women across Australia, especially those in remote, and marginalised communities - with opportunities to build confidence, leadership skills, and resilience. Our vision is a future where all girls have equal access to sport, education, and community support, empowering them to lead confident and fulfilling lives.

# The History

In March 2015, Netball Australia embraced its role as the nation's leading sport for women and girls, recognising its power to drive positive change. This vision led to the creation of the Netball Foundation, dedicated to improving access to education, health, leadership, and personal growth.

By 2017, the Foundation evolved into the Confident Girls Foundation, an independent, national not-for-profit committed to helping every girl dream big and thrive. We work to remove barriers like financial inequality, isolation, gender stereotypes, and limited opportunities, ensuring all girls can walk confidently to school, access healthcare, and live free from fear or violence.



# Issues Facing Girls in Australia

Gender inequality continues to limit opportunities for girls across the country.

- **Limited Access to Sport** – Socioeconomic factors prevent many young women from engaging in sports, depriving them of the confidence and community that sport provides.
- **Cultural & Systemic Barriers** – First Nations and multicultural communities often lack culturally safe sporting environments.
- **Economic Hardship** – The rising cost of living affects participation, with many families unable to afford registration fees, uniforms, and travel expenses.
- **Mental Health Challenges** – Without safe spaces for connection, physical activity, and leadership, girls are at increased risk of social isolation and lower self-esteem.

The Confident Girls Foundation addresses these challenges by funding and delivering programs designed to break down these barriers, ensuring all girls have the opportunity to grow, lead, and succeed. Over 85,000 women and girls have participated in more than 900 programs delivered by the foundation throughout Australia.
